

SIX COMPANIES DIRECTOR DIES

Alan McDonald Passes From Heart Attack in Santa Barbara

Alan McDonald, director of Six Companies Incorporated, Boulder dam contractors, passed away suddenly this morning in Santa Barbara, California, according to word received in Boulder City today.

Death was due to a heart attack, and came as a distinct surprise and shock to his associates.

McDonald came into Six Companies as a member of the firm of McDonald-Kahn, and has been a director in the company ever since its organization, taking an active interest in the progress of the gigantic project that brought the firm into existence.

Deceased is survived by his widow, now touring the Orient, and his son who graduated recently from Stanford university.

McDonald was one of the pioneer building contractors of the west, his firm of McDonald-Kahn having constructed many of the largest buildings in San Francisco and Los Angeles.

Funeral services will be held in San Francisco Monday.
