## **Review Operations Outlook**

- Sacramento River releases at Keswick Dam are currently 4,000 cfs.
- Feather River releases are currently at 2,400 cfs and will decrease to 2,100 cfs by December 5.
- American River releases at Nimbus Dam are 1,000 cfs.
- Stanislaus River releases at Goodwin Dam are currently 200 cfs.
- JPP exports are at 1,900 cfs and will be reduced to 900 cfs on 12/3/25.
- CCF exports are currently at 4,300 cfs and will be reduced to an estimated 3,000 cfs, as Western Delta salinity rises; No storms are shown in near term forecasts.
- DCC gates are closed.
- San Luis storage is 1.276 MAF. CVP's share is 378 TAF.
- Tides are transitioning from Neap to Spring.

## **Additional Questions or Comments**

- WWD asked whether pumping reductions were caused by D-1641 criteria exceedances or upcoming periods of drier conditions

- DWR responded that during this time of year, reservoir releases are typically reduced to conserve stored water because periods of natural rainfall and snow add water to the Delta watershed.
- DWR clarified that water project operations are in full compliance with all D-1641 requirements that are in effect. Exports are being reduced to minimize the possibility of significant water quality degradation and intrusion into the south Delta area.

## Review PA Assessment (Reclamation)

- Reclamation mentioned that salvage is expected in December, as many Winter-Run Chinook salmon were recently observed moving into the Delta.
