Topics/Actions

- Approval of the 7/1/2020 WOMET Meeting Notes: approved
 - Operational Updates CVP: finished with Trinity pulse flows, summer base flow is 450 cfs, 12,500 cfs release from Keswick, 4,000 cfs from Folsom; Stanislaus stepped release plan minimum of 200 cfs; Vernalis flow is below 500 cfs, but water quality is holding up around 500 EC versus the 700 EC standard; Ripon dissolved oxygen gage has nearby construction, the gage was moved downstream and appears to be reading properly, a check will be performed once per week for maintenance; San Luis at 248 TAF; Delta to 5 units tomorrow morning, issues Monday and Tuesday with trash rack debris that appears resolved; Monday will start Cross Valley water at Banks, ~200 cfs, pending approvals on change in point of delivery.
 - SWP: Oroville releasing 3,300 cfs to the Feather and holding for the time being; Managing to D-1641 delta outflow (5,000 cfs monthly average) with water quality looking pretty good. Exports at 2,100 cfs and scheduled to be in the range of 1,400 to 2,000 cfs which is comprised of mostly transfer water, facilitating a transfer from Merced through the end of the month; 785 TAF in San Luis.
