Review Operations Outlook (USBR, DWR)

- The current Proposed Action is to increase JPP exports from 970 to 1,800 cfs Friday 4/26 in consideration of the 2024 IOP 100 TAF curtailment requirements. No objections were raised to the proposed action.
- Spring pulse flows continue on the Sacramento River and American River; flows will decrease, reaching 6,000 cfs and 4,000 cfs respectively. Pulse flows are also ongoing on the Stanislaus River.
- Freeport daily average flows yesterday were approximately 28,400 cfs.
- Vernalis daily average flows yesterday were approximately 5,950 cfs.
- Salinity conditions across the Delta are being monitored to better understand how many
 compliance days will be required in May; April X2 requirements have been met for Port
 Chicago with an estimated 10 carryover days to May (15 days are required), likely
 resulting in 5 additional compliance days at Port Chicago which will try to be met early
 in the month.
- On the Feather River, releases from Oroville Dam increased from 3,500 cfs to 6,500 cfs today (4/23); releases will then decrease to 4,000 cfs on Friday (4/26) to coordinate with the CDFW in aiding the migration of planned hatchery releases.
- CVP shares at San Luis are under the fill mark; the CVP is continuing exchanges with the State.
