#### • Operational Updates

CVP: Lewiston (Trinity River) releases are 300 cfs, starting pulse flow on April 15 (up to 6,000 cfs) through mid-May. Whiskeytown (Clear Creek) releases are 200 cfs. Keswick (Sacramento River) releases are at 3,250 cfs. Nimbus (American River) releases are 1,000 cfs. Goodwin (Stanislaus River) releases are at 200 cfs, starting pulse flow on April 18 (up to 1,250 cfs) through May 18. Reclamation's Delta pumping is at 1 unit targeting 900 cfs. Federal share of San Luis Reservoir is 342 TAF.

SWP: Oroville-Thermalito Complex (Feather River) releases are at 1,100 cfs, reducing to 900 cfs today and to 800 cfs tomorrow. DWR is exporting 600 cfs at Banks Pumping Plant. State share of San Luis Reservoir is 589 TAF.

    - Last Friday (4/8), DWR Division of Flood Management issued Bulletin 120 for April, identifying that the drought deficiency clause was triggered in the Feather River settlement contracts; therefore, DWR notified the Feather River Settlement Contractors that their deliveries would be reduced by 50% this season.
  - o SWRCB:
    - SWRCB meeting on Tuesday April 19 to discuss the TUCP, draft
      Sacramento River Temperature Management Plan, and drought update.
    - Monday, April 18, the SWRCB is tentatively planning on issuing an updated Water Unavailability Methodology used for curtailments and draft proposed changes to emergency regulations for curtailments and a notice of a public workshop on both to be held on May 12.
- Hydrology Update (DWR and Reclamation)

- O Rain in the forecast through next Tuesday (4/19); potentially 4-6 inches in the northern Sierra, which would exceed the average for April (and the entire amount of precipitation received during the January-March 2022 period). And there will possibly be more precipitation later next week.
- TUCP/TUCO & Drought Updates
