- Operational Updates
 - CVP: Lewiston (Trinity River) releases are 6,000 cfs (pulse flow began on April 15). Whiskeytown (Clear Creek) releases are 200 cfs. Keswick (Sacramento River) releases are at 3,250 cfs. Nimbus (American River) releases are 1,000 cfs. Goodwin (Stanislaus River) releases are at 725 cfs (pulse flow began on April 18). Reclamation's Delta pumping is at 1 unit targeting 900 cfs. Federal share of San Luis Reservoir is 350 TAF.

- SWP: Oroville-Thermalito Complex (Feather River) releases are at 800 cfs. DWR is exporting 600 cfs at Banks Pumping Plant. State share of San Luis Reservoir is 591 TAF.
