- Operational Updates
 - O CVP: Lewiston (Trinity River) releases are 450 cfs. Whiskeytown (Clear Creek) releases are 325 cfs; a pulse flow is planned for June 18-27 with a maximum release 500 cfs. Keswick (Sacramento River) releases are at 4,250 cfs. Nimbus (American River) releases are 2,250 cfs (2,500 Thurs; 3,000 Fri). Goodwin (Stanislaus River) releases are at 900 cfs. Reclamation's Delta pumping is at 1 unit targeting 900 cfs. Federal share of San Luis Reservoir is 288 TAF.
 - SWP: Oroville-Thermalito Complex (Feather River) releases are at 3,500 cfs. DWR planned exports are 300 cfs. State share of San Luis Reservoir is 540 TAF.

 - o Reclamation:
 - Starting July 1, transitioning to summer ops. Increase in Folsom releases targeting 4,500-5,000 cfs to meet Delta outflow and salinity requirements. Delta exports planned to go up to three units at JPP (2,700 cfs). Decreases will occur in San Joaquin River releases as well.
 - o FWS:
 - No actions.
 - o CDFW:
 - No actions. No discussion items.
 - o NMFS:
 - No actions. No discussion items.
 - O DWR:
 - Next Tuesday (6/28), herbicide application in CCF. Zero exports on 6/28 6/29.
 - o SWRCB:
 - Working towards release of revisions to the Water Unavailability Methodology and draft proposed emergency regulations between June 20 and June 27; considering readoption of emergency regulations at SWRCB meeting on July 20.
