 - CVP: Trinity River releases are at 1,600 cfs. Sacramento River (Keswick) releases are currently at 10,000 cfs. Clear Creek is at 150 cfs. American River (Nimbus) releases are decreasing to 13,000 cfs today. Stanislaus River (Goodwin) releases are at 1,500 cfs. Reclamation's Delta pumping is 5 units targeting 4,200 cfs. Federal share of San Luis Reservoir is 956 TAF.
 - SWP: Feather River (Oroville-Thermalito Complex) releases are decreasing to 5,500 cfs today, and to 4,000 cfs tomorrow cfs Clifton Court Forebay exports are at 5,700 cfs. State share of San Luis Reservoir is at 1,059 TAF.
