REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO PROVIDE COMMENTS ON THE PUBLIC DRAFT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL WATER ACCOUNT (EWA) EIS/EIR

This letter is to request a formal extension of time to Monday, September 22, 2003 for the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Water Rights (Division) to provide written comments on the Public Draft EWA EIS/EIR. On September I 1 and 12, 2003 Diane Riddle of my staff contacted you to request an extension of time.
