Subject: Typographical Correction for EA for Delta Mendota Canal Unit Long Term Contract Renewal

Mr. Thompson,

I understand that the comment period for the DMC EA has closed, however, my clients at Fresno Slough Water District and Tranquillity Irrigation District have today advised me of some errors in Chapter 3 that may be of a typographical nature.

At Page 3-13 of the Draft EA it indicates that Fresno Slough "also owns two deep groundwater wells..." That is no longer true. Fresno Slough currently has a one-tenth ownership interest in a groundwater well, but no other operable wells.

At Page 3-24 of the Draft EA it is reported that Tranquillity Irrigation District has 6,436 irrigated acres. In fact, approximately 9700 acres of the District are, and for many years have been, irrigated.

We would appreciate it if these items could be corrected at this late date.
