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Reclamation is proposing to approve Del Puerto Water District's (Del Puerto) delivery of up to 15,000 AF of its CVP water) to Arvin-Edison for the remainder of the 2016 contract water year. This is the type of undertaking that does not have the potential to cause effects to historic properties, should such properties be present, pursuant to the NHPA Section 106 regulations codified at 36 CFR § 800.3(a)(1). Reclamation has no further obligations under NHPA Section 106, pursuant to 36 CFR § 800.3(a)(1).

Reclamation would facilitate this transfer by conveying the transfer water from the San Luis Reservoir as usual, but instead of being diverted into Del Puerto turnouts, up to 15,000 AF of Del Puerto's CVP water would be delivered to Arvin-Edison Water Storage District (Arvin-Edison) through the California Aqueduct and the Cross Valley Canal. Arvin-Edison would then convey this CVP water to their water users including water banks. The proposed action would utilize existing facilities and would not involve any new ground disturbance or construction.

This document is intended to convey the completion of the NHPA Section 106 process for this undertaking. Please retain a copy in the administrative record for this action. Should changes be made to this project, additional NHPA Section 106 review, possibly including consultation with the State Historic Preservation Officer, may be necessary.
