

39. EIR/EIS Document Distribution

In compliance with California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) review requirements, this Draft Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Impact Statement (EIR/EIS) is being circulated for public and agency review and comment for a 90-day period following the date when Sites Project Authority (Authority) files the Notice of Completion (NOC) with the Office of Planning and Research, State Clearinghouse; and U.S. Environmental Protection Agency publishes the Notice of Availability of Weekly Receipt of Environmental Impact Statement in the *Federal Register*. The DEIR/EIS is available for download from the Authority’s website, and Bureau of Reclamation’s (Reclamation’s) website provides a link to that site at <https://www.sitesproject.org/> and http://www.usbr.gov/mp/nepa/nepa_projdetails.cfm?Project_ID=139, respectively. In addition, printed copies of the Draft EIR/EIS are available at no cost at the Authority and Reclamation offices, and are available for viewing at several libraries (Table 39-1).
