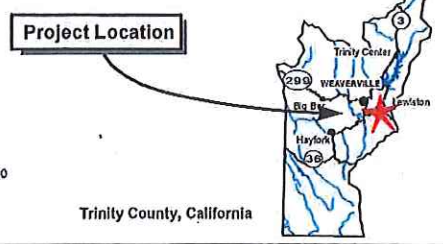

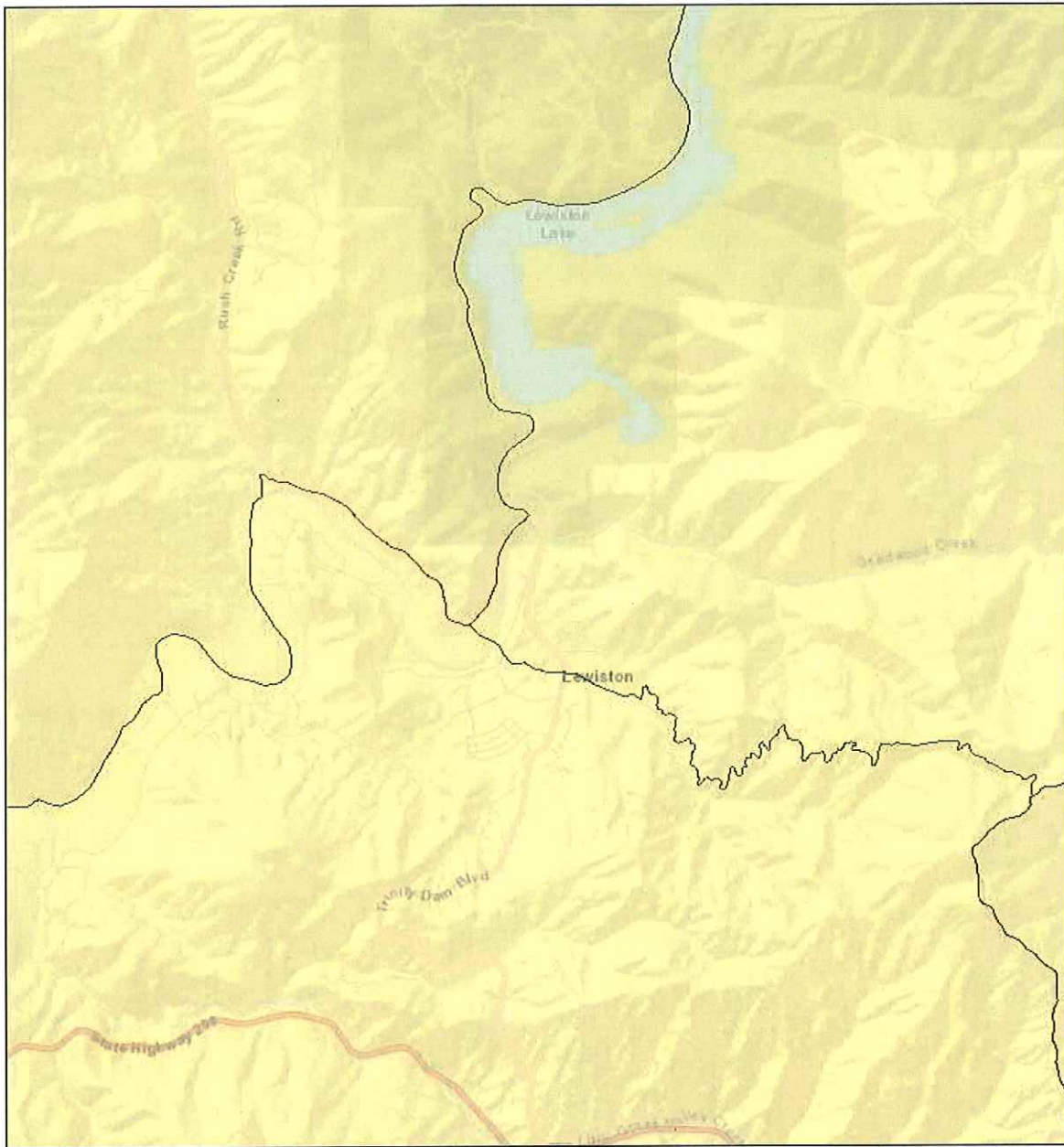

Population Density - # per sq mile



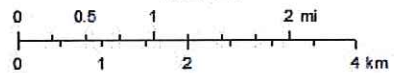

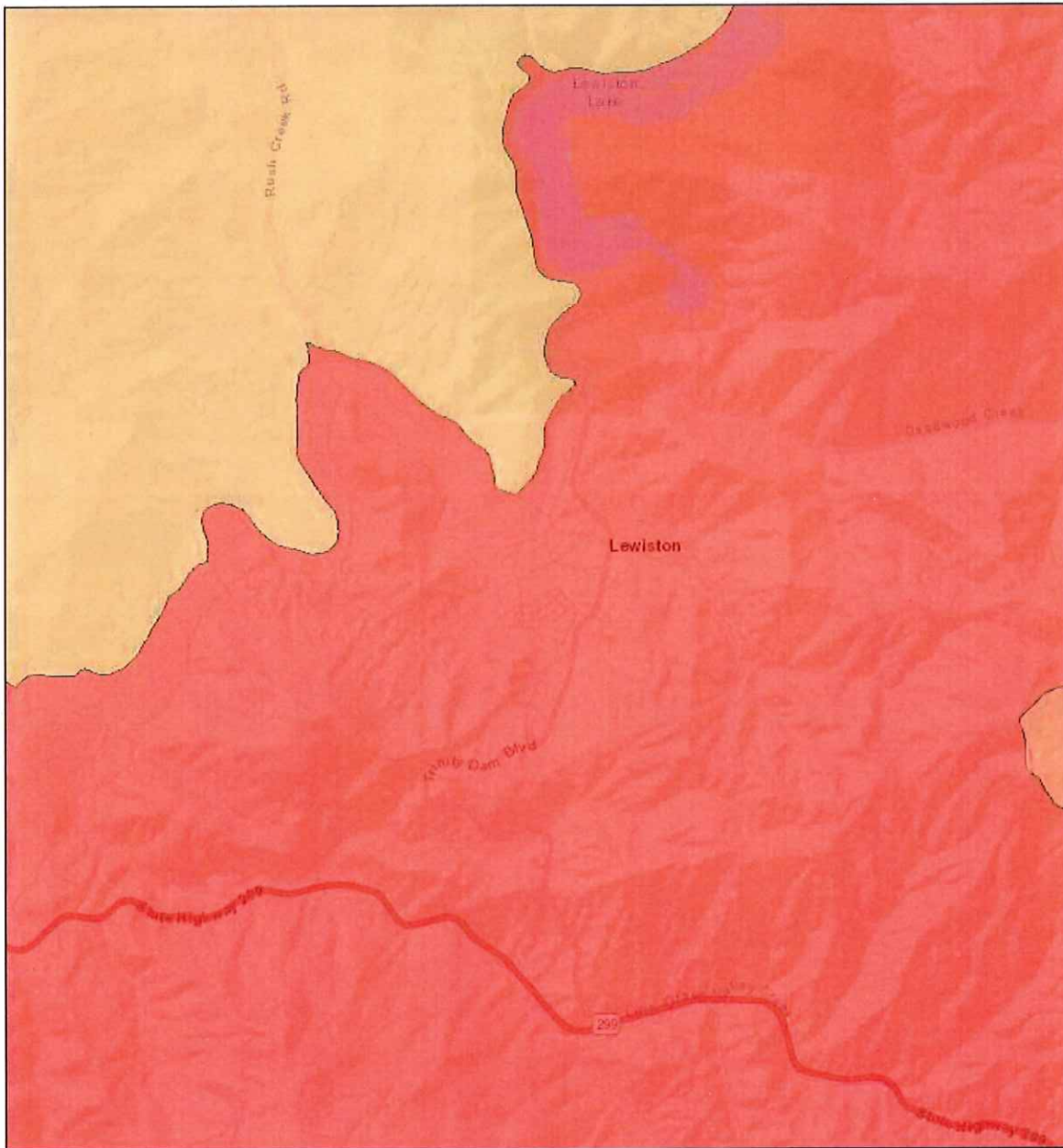

% Population below Poverty Level



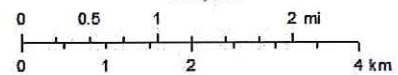

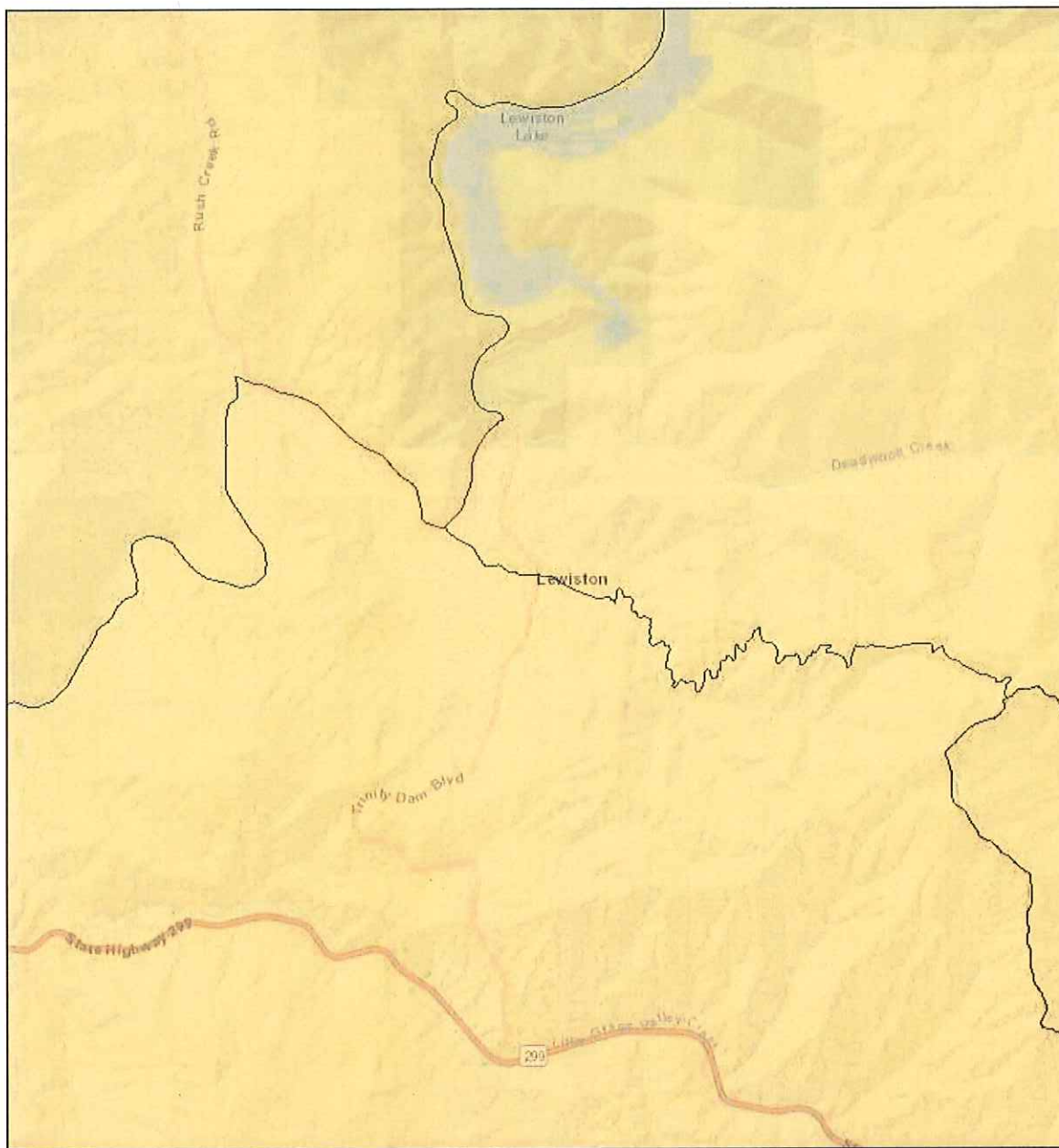

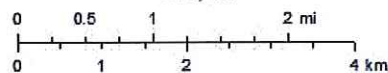
% Minority Population

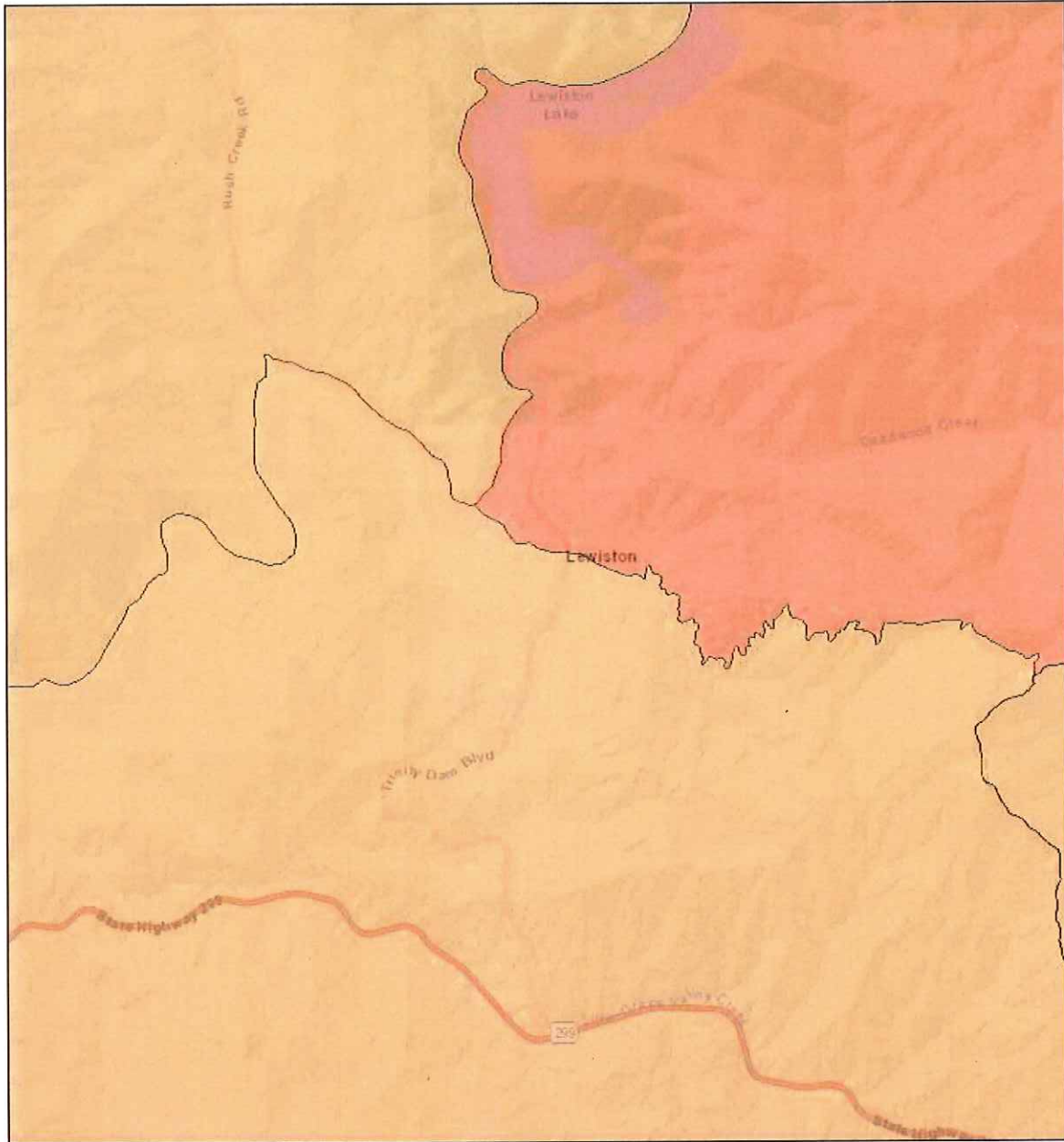

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Per Capita Income

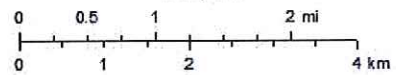
