# CULTURAL SENSITIVITY TRAINING PROJECT

- LTEMP PA
- Tribes requested for Federal employees and contractors working on river or canyon.
- \$150k not utilized 2021-2023 TWP
- No work done in 2024
- Funded 2025 at \$50k
- August 2024 AMWG tribal presentations to help restart discussion for project.
