


Remedial Actions in FY02

- 1 NPS Archaeology Monitoring Trip (funded through Reclamation)









> 42 Sites Monitored in FY2002

- Sites with structures (pueblo, small structure, historic structure, or structure with thermal feature) comprise 60% of the sample.
- Roasting/thermal features or complexes comprise 33% of the sample




Summary of Impacts to Cultural Sites

- Physical impacts observed at 92% of the sampled sites.
- Visitor impacts observed at 55% of the sampled sites.
- Physical impact frequency exceeds visitor impact frequency in reaches 4, 5, 10, and 11.



> Checkdam Updates


• 254 checkdams -- construction verses maintenance.

• Since initial construction 119 (47%) have required no maintenance.


• Maintenance is mainly on on riverbased drainages.

1175.










Work Proposed for FY2003

- > 92 sites are scheduled for monitoring.
- > 105 remedial actions are recommended with some sites having multiple recommendations.
 - Preservation Treatment (74 sites For checkdams, planting vegetation, trailwork, and other preservation work)
 - Recovery Treatment (31 sites for data recovery)





River Trip Participation (5 trips)

• Application testing, data migration/cleaning, data documentation, and design modification.





